Building Relationships through Remote Learning

The Universal Design for Learning (UDL) Guidelines teach us that in order for students to sustain effort and persistence, we must provide options to foster community and collaboration. This becomes even more important in a remote setting where person-to-person contact so typical of relationship-building is lacking.

During this session, we will discuss strategies to build community and collaboration in remote settings and give students the resources they need to challenge themselves and self-regulate when a teacher is not physically present.
