Course Objectives/Summary/Description

This hands-on workshop is designed to meet the needs of 21st century speech-language pathologists serving school-age children and adolescents with various communication difficulties. Whether the service provided is via tele-therapy or in-person, iPad apps and websites can be utilized as valid therapy materials to motivate and excite young learners. Through deep discussions and in-depth demonstrations of a number of relevant iPad apps and websites, clinicians will learn how to seamlessly infuse fun and functional digital experiences into each therapy session.

Learner Outcomes

At the conclusion of this session the participants will be able to:

- Identify apps and websites that are appropriate to use with children and adolescents in tele-therapy and in-person therapy.
- Use apps and websites that are appropriate to use with children and adolescents in tele-therapy and in-person therapy.
- Summarize unique digital motivational strategies to help children and adolescents become more effective communicators.
- Demonstrate different ways to appropriately introduce digital therapy materials into tele-therapy and in-person therapy.

Speaker Description: Dr. Erik X. Raj holds a Certificate of Clinical Competence from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association and is a practicing speech-language pathologist who works with school-age children and adolescents with various communication difficulties. He is currently an assistant professor and clinical supervisor in the Department of Speech-Language Pathology at Monmouth University in West Long Branch, New Jersey, and is also a facilitator at Camp Shout Out, a Michigan based summer camp for young people who stutter.

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Dr. Raj regularly presents interactive workshops demonstrating how speech-language pathologists can use mobile and Internet-based technologies to educate and motivate school-age children and adolescents. In addition to developing over 25 mobile apps for children with communication difficulties, he is the creator of SLPVideoGames.com, a website that features a collection of online video games with built-in speech and language flashcards.

Dr. Raj has obtained his Bachelor of Science degree in Speech Pathology and Audiology from Stockton University in New Jersey, and a Master of Science degree in Speech-Language Pathology from Misericordia University in Pennsylvania. He earned his Doctor of Philosophy degree in Communication Sciences and Disorders at Wayne State University in Detroit, Michigan. *Disclosure: Financial: Erik X Raj will receive an honorarium to speak at this conference.
