From Suspected Disabilities to Placement and Services: It All Starts with the Assessment Report

Description of workshop

This workshop will go into detail about every aspect of the assessment process including how to identify and thoroughly evaluate each area of suspected disability, integrate and analyze various forms of data within the assessment report, and document a thorough eligibility analysis. Sample language will be provided for each section of the assessment report and emphasis will be placed on aspects that increase the defensibility of the assessment. Additionally, this workshop will address how the assessment results inform goals, accommodations, placement, and services.
