CONTENT FOCUS:

There are so many timelines in special education—timelines for assessments, IEP team meetings, and responses to record requests. Some of the timelines toll during school breaks and some do not. Some timelines change when a request comes in at the end of a school year. Some timelines are extended when a student is not made available. During the COVID-19 pandemic, many of these timelines became difficult and, sometimes, impossible to keep. Regardless, all of the timelines relate back to the IEP process and parent participation in that process, which are essential elements of a free appropriate public education (“FAPE”). This workshop will review all of the special education timelines and provide LEAs with guidelines for determining why they are out of compliance with timelines, how to correct timeline issues, and how to ensure that timelines are complied with in the future.
