CONTENT FOCUS:

Connecting the Dots is an IEP essential to developing an IEP that provides a free appropriate public education ("FAPE"). We will continue our discussion of connecting the dots across three additional sessions by completing the IEP with the offer of placement and services (including least restrictive environment, transportation, emergency circumstances, and extended school year), special factors, and accommodations/modifications. We will wrap up this series with a discussion of how to write IEP team meeting notes. Practical/real life examples and cases will be reviewed as part of this series, which will provide practical applications to everyday IEP drafting. Attendees do not have to have completed our first Connecting the Dots series from September, but this series will be more meaningful for those who did attend or who watched the recordings, which are available for viewing if you contact your SELPA.
