



Annual/Triennial Reassessment

SP:M-1

It shall be the policy of the Antelope Valley SELPA that a student with a disability's progress will be reviewed on at least an annual basis. This review shall include, but is not limited to, the achievement of annual goals, the appropriateness of placement, and/or to make any necessary revisions.

The LEA shall conduct a reassessment of each child with a disability at least once every three years, or more frequently, if conditions warrant a reassessment or if the student with a disability's parent or teacher requests a reassessment and a new Individualized Education Program (IEP) to be developed.

Annual and Triennial Assessments

AR:M1a

Each LEA in the Antelope Valley SELPA shall complete all special education assessments within required timelines per federal and state laws and regulations. Each LEA in the SELPA shall complete or is required to complete triennial assessments within required timelines. Informal assessments may be conducted annually, as necessary, to provide the IEP team sufficient information to review the student with a disability's progress and the appropriateness of service(s). Formal assessments shall require written parent consent on the SELPA assessment plan form.

Each LEA shall conduct a reassessment of each student with a disability if conditions warrant a reassessment, or if the student's parent or teacher requests a reassessment, but at least once every three years. If a parent requests an assessment, a response will be made within 15 days. Each LEA will monitor assessment timelines for compliance.

The SELPA shall monitor the LEA submission of data through the state's California Longitudinal Pupil Achievement Data System (CALPADS). Each LEA shall have in place a process for data quality and monitoring CALPADS of data to include all required fields (i.e, annual, triennial assessment dates).
